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What is the **Learning Together** program?

Learning Together is three hour adult education and early childhood enrichment program that builds parents' and children's English language skills, while supporting children to develop their home language skills.

How does the **Learning Together** program work?

Learning Together offers :

- English classes for parents
- Early learning and care program for pre-school children
- Playgroup for parents and children after the English class



How does **Learning Together** help children?

- Provides opportunities to practise their home language and English
- Provides opportunities to meet and play with other children and families
- Offers a stimulating learning environment; including arts and crafts activities
- Helps children to feel confident about being separated from their parents
- Develops awareness and familiarity with the school environment

How does **Learning Together** help parents?

- Provides opportunities to practise speaking English in a supportive environment
- Offers free child care
